

Great Train Journey From St. Moritz to Tirano



One highlight of this Switzerland Tour is the 2-hour journey aboard the Bernina Express from St. Moritz to Tirano, Italy. Traveling on the "red train", the highest railway across the Alps, you'll witness glistening glaciers, stunning mountain streams, and alpine scenery, and you'll travel through tunnels and over bridges that are engineering masterpieces.



The route passes through a varied terrain of orchards, chestnut trees and vineyards on its way to Tirano in Italy. Take in stunning views of the glaciers, mountains, and gorges from the panoramic windows.

Part of the train track is considered a Unesco World Heritage site, which is one of only a few train tracks to ever be considered. Plus, the train cars are air-conditioned to keep you comfortable, and a trolley comes by to offer snacks and beverages along the way - at your own expense.



The line is harmoniously embedded in the surrounding landscape. Railway and nature blend into one. The Domleschg Valley is one of the regions in Switzerland to boast the most castles.



During your trip, ride along the Plessur River and pass two lakes, Lago Bianco, a watershed - to the south, the waters flow into the Adriatic and to the east, into the Black Sea, and Lej Nair. Enjoy the alpine scenery on the Bernina Pass, and watch as the Mediterranean atmosphere comes into view as you reach the Poschiavo Valley.
