Abraham Lincoln Birthplace National Historical Park



The Park focuses on Lincoln's life in Kentucky. The Birthplace Unit demonstrates Lincoln's humble beginnings with a symbolic birth cabin in enshrined within a neoclassical memorial building. The Boyhood Home Unit at Knob Creek Farm was home to Lincoln during his formative years. Events in Kentucky helped mold a young boy into the man who became the nation's sixteenth president.

Lunch on Your Own

Old Bardstown Village & Civil War Museum



Authentic village of ten log cabins 150 - 200 years old. This collection of original log cabins has been restored and rebuilt to represent the look of Bardstown's first settlement, when it was known as "Salem".

Also at this same location is the Civil War Museum with many rare and impressive artifacts and narrates the story of the Western Front. (Both Union and Confederate) and Women's Civil War Museum.

Heaven Hill Distillery Tour



Bourbon Hosts will guide your through the history and heritage of America's original whiskey. At the end of each tour, receive an educational Bourbon tasting of some of the most critically acclaimed Bourbons in the industry.

Three Nights - Historic Boone Tavern Hotel



Check into the stately Historic Boone Tavern Hotel where you spend three nights. Situated where the Bluegrass meets the rolling hills of Appalachia, this hotel has an historic past now stretching into its second century. It is operated by the students of Berea College who study the arts and crafts of the region.

Dinner at Boone Tavern



Dinner is included tonight in the Boone Hall Dining Room that embraces southern hospitality and is now making history, again. For the first time in 105 years, Boone Tavern is serving fine wines, Kentucky crafted and domestic beers and spirits to include the Famous Kentucky bourbons (on your own). The Berea Restaurant's cuisine celebrates quintessential Kentucky and Boone Tavern tradition through innovative preparations and flavors while providing a complete dining experience for guests wanting more.

Visit the Kentucky Horse Park



Most places can only tell you stories about legends, but at the Kentucky Horse Park, they may just trot right by you. This park is hands-on, so you can touch the horses, smell the hay and see first hand the majesty of the horse. This is a place for all of your senses! Be sure to enjoy the Hall of Champions Show, the Museum of the Horse, American Saddlebred Museum, Horse Drawn Tour, the Big Barn and more.

Guided Tour of Shaker Village



Guided walking tour winds through this premier living history site, where costumed interpreters chronicle Shaker life. Within the restored community, skilled artisans work at 19th century trades and historic farming and musical performances bring the past to life.

Dinner at Boone Tavern

Evening Entertainment - Berea College Bluegrass Ensemble



Tonight after dinner, you will be entertained with a private performance by the Berea College Bluegrass Ensemble. The students here at Berea College have been showcasing their talent with fun, lively performances for many years. They have toured throughout the eastern US, Ireland and Japan. This evening they provide your group with a unique Kentucky musical experience.

Ride on the Big South Fork Scenic Railway



Travel today to nearby Stearns, KY, where you ride the Big South Fork Scenic Railroad with an included "Coal Miner's Lunch Bag". This train travels deep in the rugged Appalachians where you visit Blue Heron, a coal camp abandoned in 1962.
