## SPAIN AND PORTUGAL SAMPLE ITINERARY

- **Tour Pace** This is a relaxed, leisurely paced tour with three-night stays in the major cities of Lisbon, Seville, Madrid and Barcelona. This allows you to get acquainted with each destination on included city sightseeing tours, which leaves time to revisit any places of interest on your own.
- **DAY 1-** DEPART USA. Board your overnight flight.
- **DAY 2-** LISBON AT LEISURE. Welcome to Portugal! Take time to relax or explore before joining your fellow travelers for a Welcome Drink. **Hotel: Marriott. (D)**

Cross the Sierra Morena Mountains and the plains of La Mancha to Madrid. Tonight, you and your fellow travelers are offered a choice of restaurants for your dining pleasure.
