Friday - July 14, 2023 – Arrive London Heathrow Airport

DAY 1: Saturday, July 15, 2023

LONDON (D)

**GROUPS:** Arrive in London's Heathrow airport, and meet your full-time local **tour manager** who will welcome you to the United Kingdom. Sightseeing begins right away, as you transfer to the nearby college town of Eton. Join **local guides** who will take you on a walking tour to explore the rich community and diverse heritage, and there is time for lunch under your own arrangements; the village has many cafes and pubs to select from. This afternoon visit **Windsor Castle**, the Official Residence of Her Majesty, and the oldest and largest occupied castle in the world; audio guides are included inside the castle. Originally built in the 11<sup>th</sup> century after the Norman invasion by William the Conqueror, the Georgian early 19<sup>th</sup> century State Apartments are magnificent. St. George's Chapel was the setting for the marriage of Prince Harry and Ms. Meghan Markle in 2018, and is the burial place of many British monarchs including Henry VIII. Continue to the city of London and settle in to your semi-centrally located accommodations. This evening **dinner** is served at a local restaurant. Return to the hotel in time for a restful sleep.
