Friday, JULY 14, 2023

OVERNIGHT FLIGHT

Overnight flights to London Heathrow, under the personal arrangements of each traveler; all participants should arrive Heathrow by 12:00PM / Noon for a 1:30PM coach departure from the airport. Any travelers arriving later would be responsible for their own transfer to Stratford-Upon-Avon.

Saturday, JULY 15, 2023

STRATFORD-UPON-AVON (D)

Arrive London, meet your **Tour Manager** and **transfer** to Stratford-Upon-Avon. Check into your hotel and freshen up. Meet for a **welcome dinner** at a local restaurant within walking distance of the hotel.

Sunday, JULY 16, 2023

STRATFORD-UPON-AVON (B,CR)

Breakfast is served at the hotel today, and each day for the remainder of your trip. **Participate in a 4-hour morning rehearsal (2-hours per choir) with a 2-hour afternoon performance at Queen Elizabeth Hall SUA or similar.** Enjoy a **cocktail reception** at a local restaurant with hot and cold appetizers.

Monday, JULY 17, 2023

STRATFORD-UPON-AVON (B)

Breakfast at the hotel. Sightseeing today includes a walking tour with **local guide** to discover the history of Stratford-Upon-Avon, including **Holy Trinity Church**, home to William Shakespeare's grave. Continue through the famous beauty of the Cotswolds by coach, including a stop in the charming town of Burton-on-Water for lunch on your own. Return to Stratford-Upon-Avon for an independent evening.

Tuesday, JULY 18, 2023

LONDON (B,D)

Breakfast at the hotel. Transfer from Stratford-Upon-Avon to London. Enjoy sightseeing along with the way with visits to **Blenheim Palace** and Oxford. Enjoy a **guided tour** of the palace and continue to Oxford for a **Harry Potter themed walking tour**, including **Christ Church College**, with many famous scenes including the Great Hall, the Bodleian Library, and the lovely college courtyards. Visit the **Sheldonian Theater**, to enjoy **one of the best indoor 360-degree panoramic views of Oxford from the Cupola.** There is the opportunity for an Informal Sing today at Blenheim Palace, Sheldonian Theater or alternate location in Oxford. The day ends in London, check-in to your centrally located hotel, refresh from your travels, and enjoy **dinner** at a local restaurant within walking distance.

Wednesday, JULY 19, 2023

LONDON (B)

Breakfast at the hotel. Participate in a 4-hour morning rehearsal (2-hours per choir) and 2-hour performance at St Paul's Actors Church Covent Garden or similar **cocktail reception** at local restaurant with hot and cold appetizers.

Thursday, JULY 20, 2023

LONDON (B,CR)

Breakfast at the hotel. Explore the capital city of England today with a **local blue badge guide** who will introduce you to London on a walking tour, where you'll enjoy a stroll from the River Thames to see Big Ben and the Houses of Parliament, Parliament Square. Board the **coach** for an afternoon **panoramic** drive. There are stops along the way for photos and to experience highlights first-hand, including Hyde Park, Marble Arch, Leicester Square, Trafalgar Square, Tower Bridge, and Tower of London (no entrances). Return to the hotel; dinner arrangements are on your own.

Friday, JULY 21, 2023

LONDON (B,D)

Breakfast at the hotel. Transfer to **Victoria and Albert Museum** for entrance. **Impromptu performance**, 4 songs 15 minutes at Victoria and Albert Museum or similar. Afternoon is free for further exploration to take in a show, shop at Harrods, etc. Enjoy a **farewell dinner** at a restaurant within walking distance of hotel.

Saturday, JULY 22, 2023

Departure (B) or Post London Festival Tour

Transfer to airport under your own arrangements for your trip home. (Or board a coach to transfer to the train station to continue the post France tour.)
